NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 42 of the Goa Excise Duty Act, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964), the Government of Goa, being of the opinion that reasonable grounds exists for doing so, hereby exempts all the licensees whose licences have become inoperative on account of their non renewal in view of the judgment dated 15/12/2016 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal Nos.12164-12166 of 2016 (Arising out of SLP(C) Nos. 14911-14913 of 2013) and subsequent Orders dated 31/03/2017 in I.A. Nos. 4-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-18, 19-21, 22-24, 25-27, 28-30, 31-33, 34-36, 37-39, 40-42 in Civil Appeal Nos. 12164-12166 of 2016, from the provisions of rules 90 and 104 of the Goa Daman and Diu Excise Duty Rules, 1964 (*hereinafter referred to as the said Rules*) subject to the following conditions, namely: —

- (i) the licensees shall declare the existing stock of liquor as on 31st March, 2017, within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of this Notification, and shall dispose the same to a wholeseller or any other operative licensee within a period of 45 days. This permission for disposal is valid for the existing stock as on 31st March, 2017 as declared by the licensee and not for any other transaction; and
- (ii) such license holders are permitted to shift the license to another premises located beyond the prohibited area or transfer the license to another person within a period of three (03) years from the date of issue of this Notification, provided the premises to which the shifting or transfer is proposed, qualifies for grant of license under the said Rules and they will be exempted from payment of license fees or any other fees for the above purpose only.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect
