In exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Goa Excise Duty Act, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964), the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa, Daman and Diu (Excise Duty) Rules, 1964, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Excise Duty (Amendment) Rules, 2015.
- (2) They shall come into force with effect from the first day of April, 2015.
- 2. Insertion of new rule 19C.— After rule 19B of the Goa, Daman and Diu (Excise Duty) Rules, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Rules"), the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "19C. Transport of imported liquor from custom bonded warehouse.— Any manufacturer/wholesale dealer intending to transport imported liquor to other States shall obtain a permit in Form E-7C to transport such liquor from custom bonded warehouse situated in this State upto check-

-post, from the Commissioner, upon payment of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) per permit. The Commissioner shall issue permit in Form E-7C on such conditions as he deems fit.".

- 3. Amendment of rule 90.— In rule 90 of the principal Rules, in sub-rule (4),—
- (i) in the second proviso, for the figure ".", the figure ": "shall be substituted;
- (ii) after the second proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

"Provided also that a licence may be granted by the Commissioner for retail sale of foreign liquor or Indian made foreign liquor or country liquor in sealed bottles in a supermarket, irrespective of place where it is situated, subject to the conditions that,—

- (i) supermarket shall have the facility of self-service;
- (ii) supermarket shall have a separate enclosure for storage and display of liquor; and
- (iii) such other conditions as the Commissioner may deem fit to impose in this regard.".
